Robert Blum co-founded and is the Managing Partner of Full Circle Capital, a firm he founded in 2005. In his capacity as Managing Partner, Mr. Blum is responsible for the overall strategic direction and management of the firm. Full Circle manages funds that invest in senior secured loans to small and middle sized corporate borrowers. From 2000 to 2005, Mr. Blum was COO of the Fairfield Greenwich Group, where he co-led the build out of that firm's capabilities to a diversified hedge fund management and multistrategy platform and helped develop a successful secured lending fund. Between 1999 and 2000, he was Executive Vice President at Internet Trading Technologies, Inc. Mr. Blum was an attorney and served various business management roles at Oppenheimer & Co., Inc./CIBC Oppenheimer, from 1989 to 1999, helping to build closed-end fund, private equity and hedge fund asset management businesses, and where he was also a member of the Management, Commitment and Due Diligence Committees. He began his career as an Associate at the law firm of Fulbright and Jaworski from 1984 to 1989. Mr. Blum received his B.A. in International Relations from the University of Pennsylvania in 1981, and his J.D. from the University of Chicago in 1984.
